

Directions to Prairie Appreciation Day

Take I-5 to the Littlerock Exit (exit 95) about 10 miles south of Olympia, follow the signs through Littlerock. At the three-way intersection at the Littlerock Elementary School continue straight through town (caution: the other two directions do not stop). At the T-intersection with Mima Road/Waddell Creek Road, go south (left) on Mima Road 2.7 miles and take a left onto an unmarked gravel road. Please drive slowly as there are children. Follow the road to its end and through the gate to the parking area. **Please leave pets at home.**
