

**How do public lands contribute to Washington's quality of life?**

**W**hen people hear public lands, they think of forest, park, recreation and may not realize that public lands provide:

- More public lands in Washington State are about 1200 mi<sup>2</sup> of high-quality public lands for outdoor recreation.
- More than 1000 miles of roads, trails, and waterways for recreation.
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- DNR-Managed Lands**
- **State Forests:** 1,200,000 acres
  - **State Parks:** 1,000,000 acres
  - **State Game Lands:** 1,000,000 acres
  - **State Trust Lands:** 1,000,000 acres
  - **State Lands:** 1,000,000 acres
- Land Base Ownerships**
- National Forest: 42%
  - State: 33%
  - Private: 15%
  - Other: 10%

**WHAT IS THE GRID ACROSS THE MAP?**

The grid is based on the North American Datum of 1983 (NAD 83). It is used to locate specific points on the map. The grid lines are spaced at 1-degree intervals.

**DISTRIBUTION & PATTERNS OF OWNERSHIP**

The map shows the distribution of various land ownership types across Washington State. National Forest lands are primarily in the western and central parts of the state. State Forest lands are scattered throughout. State Trust Lands are concentrated in the eastern part of the state.






**Possible Tenerife Trailhead Sites**

## Bus Turnaround / Existing Gate




N-S Section (looking west)




