



DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Description of proposal: Q Mountain View Timber Sale No. 106399. Sale of approximately 4,000 Mbf of timber on 208 acres, associated 3,684 feet of road construction, 14,946 feet of road reconstruction, 1,760 feet of road maintenance, and Forest Practice Application No. 3026933.

Proponent: DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES
