This is to advise you that pursuant to WAC 197-11-900 (922 through 948), the Department of Natural Resources has determined that it is Lead Agency for the following:

West Fork Fire Salvage Timber Sale #93223 and Forest Practice Application #3020612 is a harvest of approximately 7,210 MBF of timber on 1,245 acres. The proposal includes 1,794 feet of road abandonment and 93,627 feet of road maintenance. Located in Sections 13, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26 and 27, Township 34 North, Range 24 East, Sections 19, 20, 29 and 30, Township 34 North, Range 25 East W.M., Okanogan County.
