This is to advise you that pursuant to WAC 197-11-900 (922 through 948), the Department of Natural Resources has determined that it is Lead Agency for the following:

Forest Practice Application #2818896 and Brokedown Palace Timber Sale #86386 proposal is an evenaged and right-of-way harvest of approximately 3,038 MBF of timber from 69 acres. The proposal includes approximately 4,665 feet of road construction and 965 feet of road abandonment, portions of which are in the Nuxwt'iqw'em Cultural District. Located in Sections 24, 25, 36, Township 38 North, Range 05 East, and Sections 18, 19, 20, 30, Township 38 North, Range 06 East, W.M., Whatcom County.
