



DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Description of proposal: A variable retention harvest of 150.2 acres and 9.6 acres of right-of-way harvest. Approximate sale volume is 160.6 MBF using lead-end suspension, full-suspension, and ground-based logging methods. The proposal includes 8,560 feet of road construction. Due to unstable slopes, it is a Class IV-Special. The Forest Practice Application number is 2614101 - Timber Sale #30-092347 "Deer" and it is located in Clallam County.


