SUBJECT: **SEPA LEAD AGENCY & MITIGATED DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE**

This is to advise you that pursuant to WAC 197-11-900 (922 through 948), the Department of Natural Resources has determined that it is Lead Agency for the following:

**Leyh Up Sorts Timber Sale #93512 and Forest Practice Application #2614085 is a two unit variable retention harvest encompassing approximately 199 gross acres with an approximate sale volume of 3,262 MBF. Of the 199 gross acres, 112 acres are variable retention harvest, 82 acres are deferred as RMZ, 2 acres are existing roads and 3 acres are reserved as leave tree areas. The proposal includes 3,420 feet of new road construction, proposed to meet access needs into sale area and approximately 7,705 feet of pre-haul maintenance. Following the sale, 1,355 feet of road will be deactivated. Located in: Sections 30, 31 and 32, Township 32 North, Range 12 West, W.M. Clallam County.**
