

Comment: If greater than 250 cubic yards of inert, demolition, and/or wood waste is used as fill material, a Solid Waste Handling permit may be required (WAC 173-350-990). Check with your local jurisdictional health department for any permitting requirements that may be required.

Response: Per the proponent- this type of fill will not be used for fill on this proposal.

Comment: Based on the information submitted with the application, the timber harvest will be located within shoreline jurisdiction but not within proximity to a shoreline of statewide significance. JCC 18.25.460(a) addresses Forest Practices in shoreline jurisdiction and states, "Timber harvesting and forest practices activities that do not meet the definition of development in Article II of this chapter shall be conducted in accordance with the Washington State Forest Practices Act (Chapter 76.09 RCW), WAC Title 222, and the 1999 Forest and Fish Report, and any regulations adopted pursuant thereto."

Response: Per the proponent- No new development is included in this activity, there for no shoreline permit is needed. All activity will be conducted according to Forest Practices and the DNR HCP.
