



DETERMINATION OF NON-SIGNIFICANCE

Description of proposal: The proposal consists of 82 acres of even-age timber harvest and 4 acres of right-of-way harvest totaling approximately 2,077 MBF. Additionally, this proposal includes 7,893 feet of road construction, 9 stream crossings, and 0.5 acres of rock pit expansion. A portion of this proposal will take place on or adjacent to potentially unstable landforms. This review covers the Forest Practices Application (FPA) activities as described in FPA #2932506.

The proposal is located approximately 4.0 air miles southwest of Mossyrock, Washington.
