

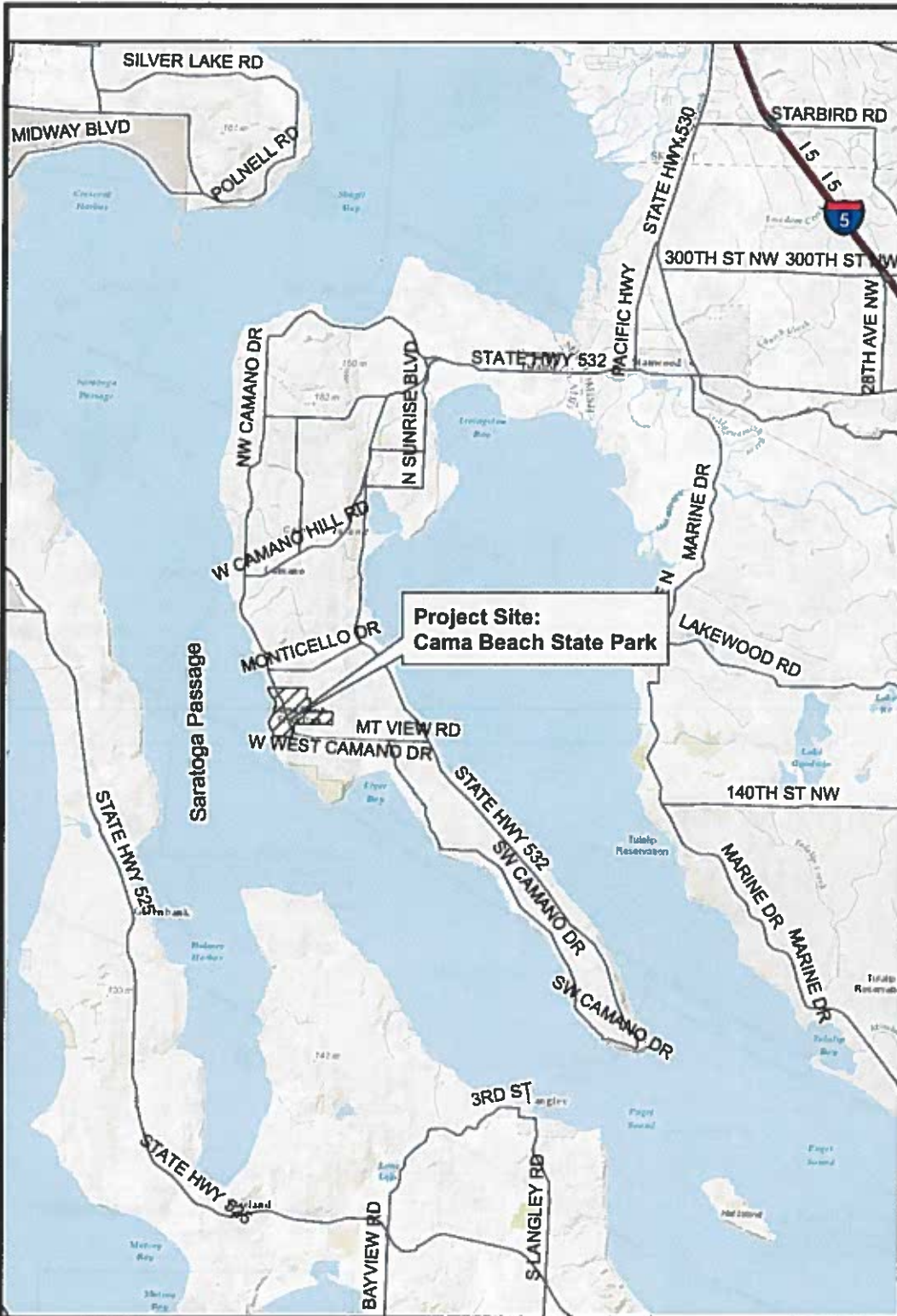

Applicant Name: Washington State Parks and Recreation

Type of Authorization - Use: Lease – Marine Railway and 4 Mooring Buoys

Term: 12 years

Description: This agreement will allow the use of State-owned aquatic lands for the sole purpose of a Marine Railway and 4 mooring buoys. They are located in the Cama Beach State Park on the Saratoga Passage, in Island County, Washington.



Driving Directions: From Interstate 5, take exit 212 and continue west on WA-532 W to Camano Island. Continue on NE Camano Drive. After approximately 5.8 miles, turn right onto E Monticello Drive. Next, after approximately 2 miles turn left on SW Camano Drive and after approximately one mile turn right into the Cama Beach Park Entrance.

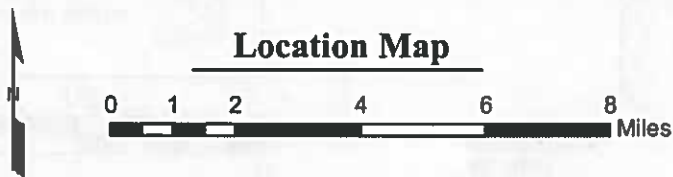
