



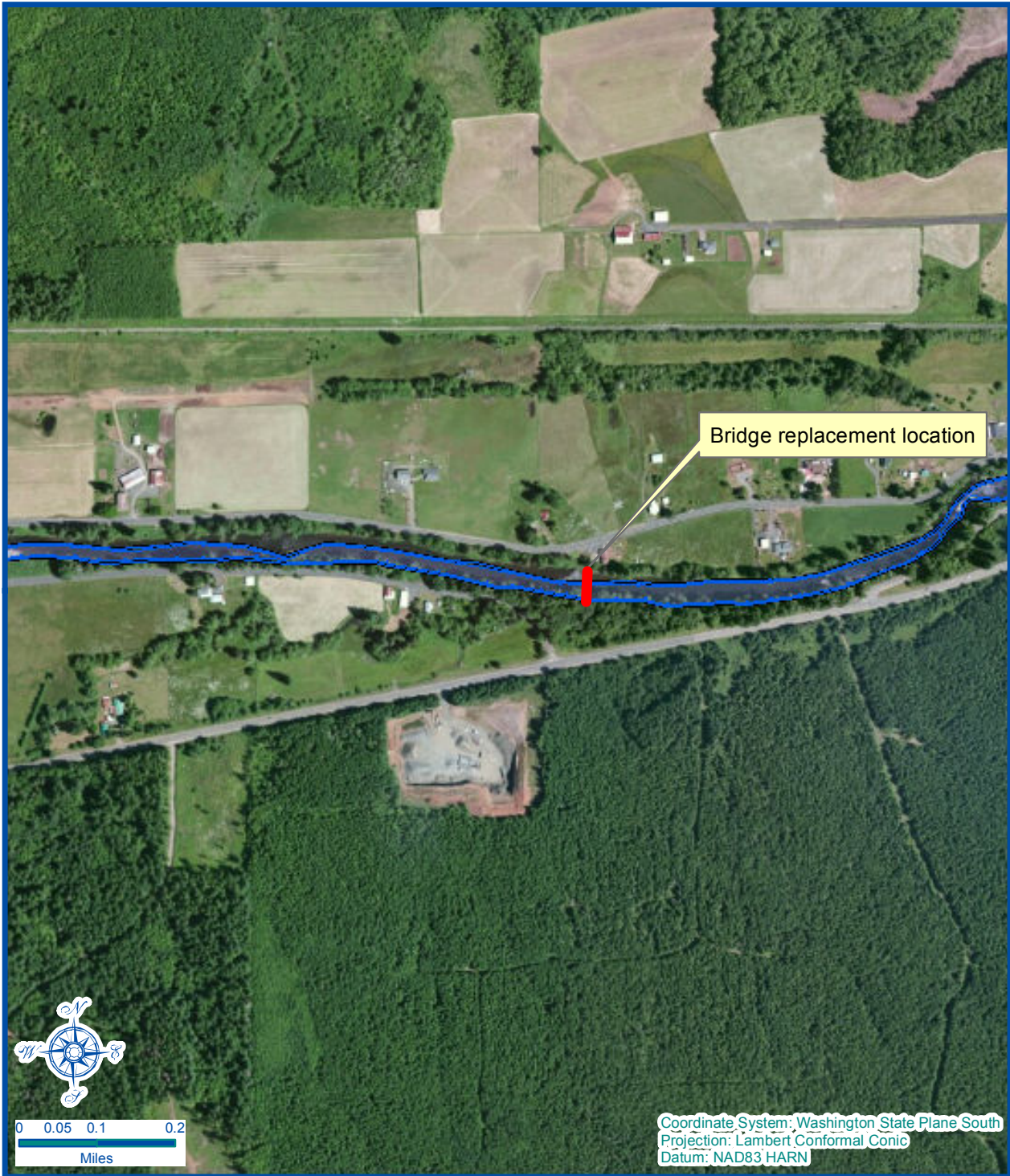

Description: This agreement will allow the use of State-owned aquatic lands for the sole purpose of one (1) steel truss public bridge. It is located over the Chehalis River, in Lewis County, Washington.

Lewis County is replacing a bridge over the Chehalis River in the Meskill Area. The previously existing bridge was washed away in the 2007 flood. The new bridge will be located 1/2 a mile upstream from the old bridge crossing.
