



Application for Use of State-owned Aquatic Lands

Applicant Name: Clark Public Utilities
County: Clark County
Water Body: East Fork Lewis River
Type of Authorization - Use: Public Utility Easement for one (1) 24-inch waterline, one (1) 8-inch waterline, and one (1) fiber optic conduit
Authorization Number: 51-091401
Term: Thirty (30) years
Description: This agreement will allow the use of State-owned aquatic lands for the sole purpose one (1) 24-inch waterline, one (1) 8-inch waterline, and one (1) fiber optic conduit. It is located under the East Fork Lewis River, in Clark County, Washington.

Clark Public Utilities is developing its Paradise Point Wellfield and Treatment Plant site to expand public drinking water service. In order to access the wells, Clark Public Utilities is seeking an easement to run waterlines to and from the wells, and fiber optic lines for internal communication. The lines will be placed beneath the river by a horizontal directional drill.
