Type of Authorization- Use: License – Public access and use as well as support generating activities related to the educational and recreational center, workshop, moorage, and hand launching of vessels.

Authorization Number: 20-A12478
Term: 5 years

Description: This agreement will allow the use of State-owned aquatic lands for the sole purpose of Center for Wooden Boats operations and activities as further described below. It is located on Lake Union, in King County, Washington.

Use of Waterway 4 is for an educational and recreation center involving vessels. The facility is utilized for the education of boat operation, boat building, and the history of vessels. The Center for Wooden Boats (CWB) may display historical vessel elements and provide programming activities associated with the moorage of CWB related vessels and for no other purpose. On-site there is a pre-84 workshop, museum/office center, boat rental kiosk, an information center and display area, vessel moorage and water taxi ticket booth.
