

Description: This agreement will allow the use of State-owned aquatic lands for the sole purpose of: Maritime Pier for public use and access, and loading /unloading of fishing and passenger vessels. It is located in Gig Harbor Bay, in Pierce County, Washington.

The City of Gig Harbor wishes to re-lease the tidelands associated with the newly built Maritime Pier facility. Harbor area lease 22-077100 is associated with this lease; it expires 6/24/2034.

The facility consists of two (2) seven (7) pile creosote dolphins, a new pier, ramp, float assembly and thirty two (32) supporting steel piling. Pier and floats are grated to a minimum of 50% with 60% open space, ramp is fully grated.
