**Description:** This agreement will allow the use of State-owned aquatic lands for the sole purpose of vessel moorage. It is located in Lake Union Waterway 3, in King County, Washington.

The Seattle Department of Transportation requests a Right of Entry to temporarily station one of the Argosy Cruises vessels in Waterway 3 of Lake Union. The vessel will be temporarily displaced from its normal moorage by construction associated with the Elliott Bay Seawall Project. Cruise passengers will board and leave the vessel in South Lake Union Park.
