July Policy Committee meeting

- 1. Review the timeline for presenting the deliverable to the Forest Practices Board at November 2016 meeting.
- 2. Electrofishing
 - a. Review the Co-Chairs' draft on establishing the regulatory F/N break related to electrofishing.
 - b. Review the aggregated responses from caucuses on how, when, and where to use electrofishing.
 - c. Frame further work (when, how) for establishing the regulatory break.
- 3. Protocol Surveys: review the direction to the small group to revise the protocol survey method based on the Electrofishing Technical Group's report.
- 4. Off-Channel Habitat: review ideas from the Co-Chairs.
- 5. Review the AMPA's recommendations on how to implement the Physicals Proposal Initiation.

August Policy Committee meeting

- 1. Off-Channel Habitat
 - a. Review the Off-Channel Habitat Technical Group's report.
 - b. Review and/or continue discussion on the Co-Chairs' recommendations.
- 2. Protocol Surveys: review the small group's recommended draft protocol survey method.
- 3. Presentation from DNR on the anticipated changes to the water typing program administration.

September Policy Committee meetings – TWO MEETINGS (Sept 8 and later in the month, TBD)

- 1. Review work to date (TBD, depending on timelines).
- 2. Review illustrations outlining the new rule/guidance language (help translate theoretical ideas to practicality).

October Policy Committee meeting

1. Review full package that will be presented to the Board.

November Policy Committee meeting
