Directions: From Seattle/Tacoma: Exit 130 (56th Street **West**) from Interstate 5 (north or south) and follow to Orchard, where it becomes Cirque Drive. Follow Cirque to Grandview and then go south (left) on Grandview to the Environmental Services Building.

From Dupont/Olympia: Take the Dupont exit (exit 119 from I-5 north) west towards Dupont-Steilacoom Road. Turn right onto Barksdale Avenue and immediately right onto Dupont-Steilacoom Road. Road name changes to Dupont Steilacoom Highway. Bear right onto Lafayette Street. Road name changes to Chambers Creek Road West. Turn left onto 64th Street West. Go around the roundabout left into the entrance to the Environmental Services.
