Units 1, 2, and 3: From Springdale, travel west on Springdale-Hunters Road approximately 11.1 miles to Allen Rd. Turn West onto Allen Rd; travelling approximately 0.6 mile. Turn South onto E293907B. Travel south on E293907B approximately 1.0 mile to the E293907C. Turn South onto the E293907C. To Unit 2: Go approximately 0.1 mile through the gate to Unit 2. To Unit 1: Continue on the E293907C approximately 0.1 mile to the E293918E. Turn West onto E293918E, continue 0.4 mile to Unit 1. To Unit 3: From intersection of E293907C and E293918E, continue southerly on E293907C approximately 0.7 mile to E293918F. Turn Southeast onto E293918F, travel approximately 1.2 miles to E293918P. Turn onto E293918P and travel approximately 0.1 mile to Unit 3.

Units 4, 5, and 7: From Springdale, travel West on the Springdale-Hunters Road approximately 5.4 miles to Lyons Hill Rd. Turn South onto Lyons Hill Road travelling approximately 1.3 miles to the junction of Bowler Road. To Unit 5: At the Y, continue southbound on Lyons Hill Road approximately 0.8 mile to E293912E.
