All trees 60 inches in Diameter at Breast Height (DBH) and greater shall not be felled, unless for safety reasons, which must be approved by the Contract Administrator. If trees 60 in DBH or greater need to be felled for safety reasons, trees will be left where felled. Falling and Yarding will not be permitted from November 1 to April 30 unless authorized in writing by the Contract Administrator or on weekends, State recognized holidays, or from the hours of 8:00pm to 6:00am.

ROADS:

7.25 stations of required construction. 5.80 stations of required reconstruction. 30.40 stations of required prehaul maintenance. 19.85 stations of decommissioning. Pre-haul maintenance, reconstruction, rock haul, timber haul and Road construction will not be permitted from November 1 to April 30 unless authorized in writing by the Contract Administrator or on weekends, State recognized holidays or from November 1 to April 30. On the PA-I-2600, PA-I-2610, PA-I-2620 Roads and the Place Pit, no road work, right-of-way timber falling and yarding, rock pit operations or operation of heavy equipment can be performed during the marbled murrelet nesting season (April 1 through September 23) is restricted to two hours after sunrise to two hours before sunset. Rock identified to be used out of a State lands rock pit shall meet specifications as identified within the Road Plan, which will be determined by the Contract Administrator. If the rock does not meet the specifications, a commercial source shall be used that does and at the Purchaser's expense. The hauling of forest products will not be permitted from November 1 to April 30 unless authorized in writing by the Contract Administrator.

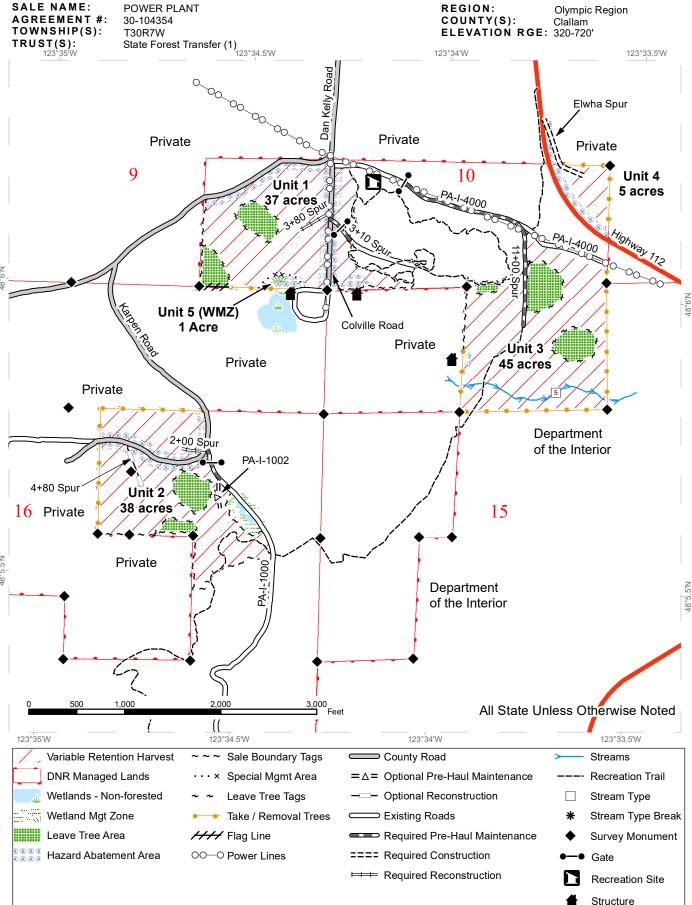

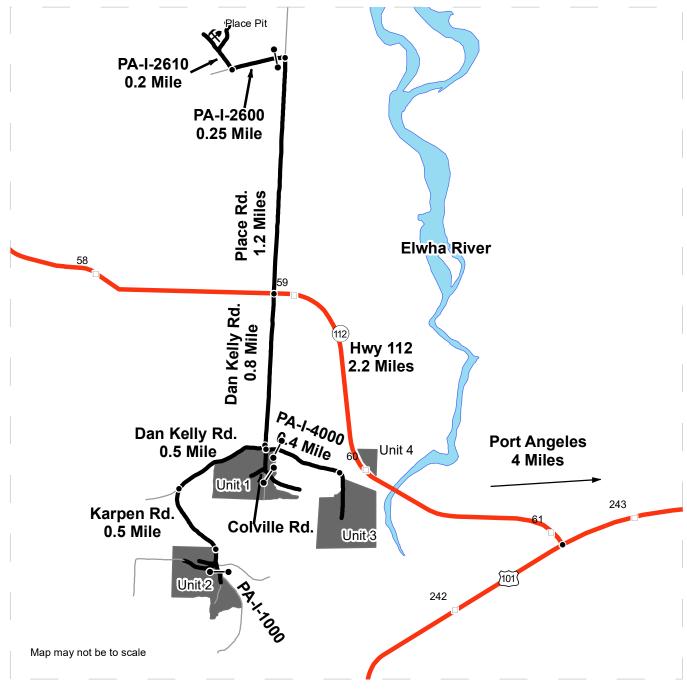

ACREAGE DETERMINATION

Acreage for Units #1, #2, and #3 were determined by traversing boundaries by GPS. Acreage for Unit #3, and Right of Way Units #5, #6, and #7 were determined by GPS and by multiplying length times width. GPS data files are available at DNR's website for timber sale packets. FEES:

\$80,614.00 is due on day of sale. \$9.00 per MBF is due upon removal. These are in addition to the bid price.

SPECIAL REMARKS: This sale contains Douglas-fir high quality logs. See Cruise.

Trees marked with three bands of blue paint in Right of Way Unit #7 along the 1000 Road are to cut and placed at each Type 3 stream crossing within 25 feet of the stream on either side of the streambank. Trees that have been pre-marked with three bands of blue paint are Douglas fir and at least twice the width of the ordinary high water mark. All other marked trees within Right of Way Unit #7 can be cut and removed once a premarked tree has been cut and placed in a Type 3 stream. See Road Plan clause 3-6 for additional information.

Non-tradeable individual leave trees within Units #2 and #3 are marked with two bands of blue paint.

Timber haul will not be allowed on the Stossel Creek Road between the 1000 Road and 2730 Road junction. Only equipment haul and light vehicle use will be allowed on this section of Stossel Creek Road due to maintenance and sedimentation issues.





A separate sealed bid and envelope must be submitted for each log sort. Prospective Purchasers may bid on any or all log sorts. On the day of sale the Purchaser must bring their bid deposit up to 10% of their total bid price. Complete bidding procedures and auction information may be obtained from the Pacific Cascade Region Office in Castle Rock WA. Phone number (360)577-2025.

TIMBER EXCISE TAX:

Purchaser must pay the forest excise taxes associated with the log sorts delivered to them. The tax rate for this sale is 4.2 %. Taxable Stumpage = Total Delivered Value – (Harvest Cost + Estimated Haul Cost + ARRF). For more information contact the Department of Revenue, Forest Tax Section at 1-800-548-8829.

Use the following rates for estimating taxable stumpage:

Harvest Cost = \$0.00 per MBF for sorts 1, 2, 3, 4, 6, 7 and 8, \$14.00 per Ton for sorts 10 and 11 and \$16.00 per Ton for sorts 5 and 9.

SPECIAL REMARKS: The successful Purchaser(s) will be required to purchase logs from the sale area upon delivery to their location specified in the bid submitted. Logs will be delivered to the Purchaser's delivery location by the State's contract harvester. Purchaser is responsible for weighing and scaling costs. All tonnage loads will be weighed and all mbf loads will be scaled at State approved locations. The State reserves the right to determine where logs are authorized to be scaled and weighed.

Thinning Prescription: Unit 1

• Purchaser shall leave a residual stand that shall achieve the following evenly distributed across the sale area.

Average spacing of 19 feet x 19 feet


To accomplish this prescription, fallers shall harvest trees starting with smallest diameter trees working up to the larger trees (thin from below). The following take tree preference shall be followed to achieve the desired residual stand spacing:

- 1) all hardwoods
- 2) Western hemlock
- 3) defective, or diseased, Douglas-fir
- 4) smallest diameter Douglas-fir
- Examples of defect are trees with broken tops and little canopy, well developed spike knots, and highly sinuous forms should be prioritized for take.
- Where the prescription would leave an opening greater than 30 feet in diameter, the Purchaser must leave a conifer take tree from the largest diameter, largest crown class, best form, and undamaged.
- Western redcedar is not to be cut without prior approval of the Contract Administrator (CA). Only trees necessary to facilitate harvest operations or those which pose safety hazards shall be considered for approval.

Riparian Forest Restoration Strategy Trees

- RMZ's shall have an 8-13 inch diameter limit for cutting.
- Three enhancement conifer trees per thinned RMZ acre from the largest diameter class of thinned trees shall be felled toward streams and left as down woody debris.
- Two enhancement conifer trees per thinned RMZ acre from the largest diameter class of thinned trees shall be cut in a manner that facilitates snag creation and recruitment (girdled or topped).
- These enhancement trees are in addition to the residual stocking targets mentioned above, and should be distributed evenly throughout the RMZs.


