Teanaway Community Forest Advisory Committee Communication and Participation Agreement

The following rules of engagement are a condition for participating on the Teanaway Community Forest Advisory Committee and comprise the communication and participation agreement by each Advisory Committee member.

- 1. <u>Attendance Agreement:</u> Members are expected to attend all meetings (barring unusual circumstances). If a member cannot attend, they will notify the Facilitator prior to the meeting.
- 2. Opt-Out Agreement: If, after two months, a participant finds they cannot make the commitment or do not want to participate any longer, they have the opportunity to respectfully opt out of the Advisory Committee.
- 3. No alternates or substitutes will be accepted on behalf of any Committee member besides the representatives of the Yakama Nation, Department of Ecology, and Kittitas County Board of Commissioners. If a member cannot attend a meeting and would like to send a representative, the representative can attend as a member of the public and take notes for briefing purposes.
- 4. Members of the Advisory Committee agree to communicate with their constituent groups and general public on a regular basis so that they may provide views and insights to inform the rest of the committee.
- 5. Members agree to read material in advance and come to meetings prepared.
- 6. Members are committed to "being at the table" (e.g., working as a member of a team) and working toward mutually agreeable solutions in a positive manner.
- 7. Agreement to speak and act in a respectful manner. Focus on the issue, not the person.
- 8. Agreement to listen to others.
- 9. Agreement to be open to other points of view.
- 10. If a Committee member voices disagreement, he/she will present an alternative option or solution.
- 11. Agreement to provide confidentiality upon request.
- 12. Each committee member has an equitable amount of "air time" to voice their ideas and points of view and to share opportunities to speak.
- 13. The Advisory Committee meetings are working sessions, members of the public who attend will be provided a public comment period at the end of the meeting to speak.
