| Request Description: The Road Prescription-Scale Effectiveness Monitoring Project Team requests CMER review of the revised STE DIP. In the July 2020 CMER meeting the Roads Project Team shared an initial version of the STE DIP. Since that time, the experimental set-up has been modified to improve the practicality of implementation and to more efficiently capture the data necessary to inform our empirical model in development.
