### About Mima Mounds:


Mima Mounds Natural Area Preserve supports a mysterious mounded landscape due to its unique topography. This site was designated a National Natural Landmark in 1968 by the National Park Service.

This 637-acre site protects the best remaining example of the unusual rolling "mima mound" prairie landscape.
