

THE EVERGREEN STATE COLLEGE MASTER OF ENVIRONMENTAL STUDIES PROGRAM VISITS THE OLYMPIC EXPERIMENTAL STATE FOREST

More than 60 students and their professors from The Evergreen State College MES program visited the OESF as part of a 3-day tour of the Olympic Peninsula in October, 2015. The first day, the students attended a presentation by DNR forest ecologist Dr. Richard Bigley on history of forest management in the region and current forest practices on public and private lands.

The strong wind prevented the planned field tour the next day. Instead, the group spend the day indoors starting with seminar on the book "The Final Forest" by William Dietrich followed by two presentations by the OESF Research and Monitoring Manager Dr. Teodora Minkova on northern spotted owl conservation and the OESF research and monitoring program.
