4. The Department of Natural Resources' consideration of the application includes a field inspection and an administrative review to determine the impact the request will have on the management of the lands involved and to determine if the request is in accordance with the statutes of the State of Washington.
5. State leases, to entities other than public agencies, require public advertising and a public auction.
