**Permit must be in vehicle window and available upon request**

**Do not cut any standing trees, snags, or blow-down timber.**

Only cut within the boundaries of the unit(s) outlined on the map, and only within 200 feet from truck roads.

**Firewood is for personal use only**

- 1) Limit of 6 cords per family with this permit.
- 2) Cut only wood that is dead and on the ground.
- 3) Cedar is not authorized for removal.
- 4) Firewood cutting will be allowed during the closed season if the following conditions are met:
  - o No cutting is allowed on fire precaution level 2 or above. Call 1-800-323-2876 for this information.
  - o All fire tool requirements must be met for power saws, including approved spark arresters, fire extinguishers, and shovel.
  - o Smoking is not allowed in unit on a level 2 or above day, except in vehicles.

**Obey all signs posted in the unit**

- 5) Do not disturb ANY planted seedlings.
- 6) Motorized equipment and/or vehicles must stay on roads (do not drive on skid trails).
- 7) **No removal or cutting of firewood is allowed more than 200 feet from truck roads.**
- 8) **Do not cut firewood on the road. Keep road surface and ditches clean.**

**Any false statement made in this application or violation of these terms is punishable as a Gross Misdemeanor.**

RCW 79.15.440

**This permit may be voided by any State DNR Forester on demand.**

**The firewood area will be closed if abuse or permit violations occur.**







**DRIVING DIRECTIONS:**

From Sedro-Woolley, travel 11.0 miles south on HWY 9 to Lake Cavanaugh Road.  
 Turn left and travel east 10.2 miles to South Shore Drive.  
 Turn right and travel east 4.4 miles to the Lake Cavanaugh Mainline (LC-ML).  
 Turn right, pass through the gate, and travel east 1.2 miles to junction.  
 To reach Unit 1 and the center of Unit 2, stay to the right and continue on the Lake Cavanaugh Mainline (LC-ML) at the junction.  
 Unit 2 begins on both sides of the LC-ML 0.7 miles from the junction.  
 Unit 1 is located at the end of LC-ML, approx. 2.5 miles past the junction.  
 To reach Unit 3, instead turn left onto Lake Cavanaugh-13 (LC-13) at the junction and travel approx. 0.5 miles to the beginning of the unit.  
 The top of Unit 2 can then be reached by traveling approx. 1.1 miles further on LC-13.
