### History of WA IMTs —as Gary's memory recalls:

- Prior to 1985 DNR and USFS had separate IMTs (5 in DNR and ability to staff 3, 3 in USFS)
- > 1989 Intent established for Interagency IMTs
- > 1994 5 WA Interagency Type 2 IMTs, and 5 WA State Mob Teams, and 3 Type 1 USFS IMTs (WA and OR)
- > 2000 Formed Geoboard and Integrated WA State Mob and DNR into 5 "All Hazards" Type 2 IMTs with up to 50 members
- > ~2012 Merge WA Type 2 IMTs with the Oregon Federal Type 2 IMTs to create 10 NW (WA and OR) Type 2 IMTs
- > 2023 Dropped from 7 to 6 Type 2 IMTs and 2 Type 1 IMTs (continual decrease in participation and qualifications while fire workload increased since 2012)
