Chair welcomed members. Addressed challenging times, thankful members 11 12 were able to make meeting. Last minute's meetings were approved. 13 Minutes Approved: Motion to approve minutes from February 13, 2020, Juli motioned and Angel 14 seconded motion. UCF Program Staff Introductions: Ben's promotion to UCF Manager announced. Introduction to Daria 15 Gosztyla, new Urban Forestry Outreach & Projects Specialist. Daria comes from Grand Rapids, MI with 16 17 background in non-profit and municipal urban forestry work. 18 **UCF Program Updates, Ben Thompson and Daria Gosztyla:** 19 **Tree City USA** 20 94 Tree City USA's submitted state-wide, a little lower than last year. Mountlake Terrace 21 is the newest Tree City USA. Port Angeles, WA did pull through with application; Othello 22 and Shelton didn't complete applications this year. 23 **Tree Line USA** 24 13 Tree Line utilities state-wide. Two new utilities joined, Franklin county PUD and 25 **Cowlitz County PUD** 26 **Tree Campus USA** 27 13 Tree Campus USA's submitted state-wide. Three new ones were Olympic College, 28 Wenatchee Valley College, and Central Washington University 29 **Washington State Arbor Day** 30 Governor issued State Arbor Day proclamation. Three baby moon trees were planted at the February WCFC meeting as part of the NASF Centennial Challenge. UCF program was 31 32 supposed to plant the 100<sup>th</sup> tree on Arbor Day with governor but it was canceled due to 33 the pandemic; a virtual Arbor Day tree tour was held instead on Facebook Live. 34 Grants Update—2 categories (Community Planning and Engagement Grant and Community 35 Forestry Assistance Grant) 36 Ben expressed plan to release 2021 grants and call for proposals one month earlier this 37 year, in September 2020, and talked about plans to revamp and streamline the grant

program to further suit the needs of our communities.

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# **Evergreen Community Act Update**

Revisions to the Evergreen Communities Legislation did not pass out of committee this spring. DNR initially received provisional funding for two pilot projects, but due to the current uncertain financial situation set forth by COVID-19, the funding is expected to be dropped.

# **April Tree Link**

April's Tree Link featured Linden's final thoughts and farewell prior to retirement, an explanation to communities about the decision of Arbor Day Foundation to forego the Tree City USA requirement of an Arbor Day Celebration this year, and provided information to communities on alternative ways to celebrate Arbor Day. The newsletter encouraged fall-time Arbor Day celebrations.
