This is to advise you that pursuant to WAC 197-11-900 (922 through 948), the Department of Natural Resources has determined that it is Lead Agency for the following:

**Far South Timber Sale #92368 and Forest Practice Application #3019927 is a sale of approximately 2,726 MBF of timber on 183 acres, associated 1,873 feet of road construction, 140 feet of road reconstruction and 14,823 feet of road maintenance. Located in Section 36, Township 24 North, Range 44 East and Section 16, Township 24, North, Range 45 East, W.M., Spokane County.**
